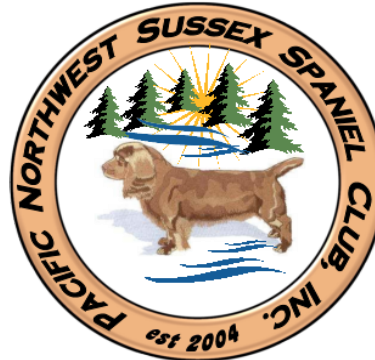

Attention Exhibitors

Exhibitor Rule Change Effective 01/01/2010

Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1.

On May 12, 2010 the Grand Championship competition will start concurrent with the implementation of the 2010-2011 Schedule of Points. Competition for this new title will be judged concurrently with Best of Breed competition at both all-breed and specialty shows.

Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008. The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cents recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Events Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. These event services and recording fees shall be forwarded to the American Kennel Club along with all other required event results with seven (7) days of the close of the event.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, Please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided. No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent entered a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. **THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.** Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, No refund of entry fee may be made. Returned checks shall have a collection fee of **\$20.00** added to the amount of the check.

No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Show. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Event.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the Show.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 2:00pm, Wednesday, August 17^h, 2011.

SET UP OF TENTS/EQUIPMENTS MAY NOT BE WITH 15 FEET OF ANY RINGS. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED

Grooming will be in the livestock building located in the northeast corner of the grounds. **USE OF ALL POWER OUTLETS IS AT USER'S OWN RISK. LOADING & UNLOADING: There will be NO loading or unloading of crates/dogs at ringside during show hours! Loading and unloading** will be in the livestock building only located in the northeast corner of the grounds. Access to the Livestock Building will be off 284th Ave SE – follows signs **on Friday- gate open at 6:00am**

No vehicles will be allowed on the show grounds after 7:00am on Friday unless they have reserved parking.

PARKING INFORMATION: THERE WILL BE NO DAY PARKING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS No practicing allowed in rings at any time. **No dogs to be left overnight in grooming building.** Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog(s). No skateboards, roller blades, scooter or bikes will be allowed on the show grounds.

Best of Breed Competition	

Best of Breed Competition : The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed/Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed/Variety Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Award of Merit: The judge may at his discretion, recall into the ring one dog/bitch to receive Judges Select Rosettes. This Rosette is reserved for the quality animal the Judge feels is worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple dog entries)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, must MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - Two dogs of the same breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner and both dogs must be entered in another class.

Novice Intermediate Class – For boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class- For boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - For boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class – For boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class- For boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

FROM THE NORTH/EASTSIDE: Drive south on Interstate 405 to Maple Valley Highway (State Route 169); proceed south to Enumclaw. SR169 becomes Porter in town. At the traffic light at the intersection of Porter and Griffin Avenue, turn left (east) onto Griffin Avenue. At the traffic light at the end of Griffin, turn left (east) onto SR410/Roosevelt, then right (south) at the light onto 284th Avenue. The Expo Center will be on your left.

FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH ON I-5 – Highway 18 East to Auburn, then State Route 164 east into Enumclaw SR164 becomes Griffin Avenue in town. At the traffic light at the end of Griffin, turn left (east) onto SR410/Roosevelt, then right (south) at the light onto 284th Avenue. The Expo Center will be on your left.

FROM THE SOUTH – Take State Route 512/167 and go east on SR410. Go through Bonney Lake and Buckley. Continue on SR410 into Enumclaw and through to 284th Ave SE. Turn right (south) at the light onto 284th Avenue. The Expo Center will be on your left.

PARKING INFORMATION

General Information

All parking is a privilege extended by Olympic Kennel Club and the Enumclaw Expo Center. Any arguing, abusive language or failure to follow the rules, regulations or instructions of the club or parking personnel will cause you to be escorted from the show site, forfeit all parking privileges without refund of fees and possible discipline by the Event Committee. All parking is at user's own risk. Olympic Kennel Club, Enumclaw Expo Center and J.I.F.Y.S. assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.

No vehicles will be allowed on the show grounds after 7:00am on Friday unless they have reserved parking.

- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep and leave the area clean
- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available in the general parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings.
- All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than one hour following Best In Show Sunday, August 21, 2011.
- No vending in parking areas without a permit.
- All parking fees must be paid in U.S. funds.
- Fire Lanes MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES. Vehicles subject to towing at owner's expenses with no prior notification.

Loading/Grooming Information.

There will be NO loading or unloading of crates/dogs at ring side during show hours! Loading and unloading will be at the Livestock Barn **ONLY – gate opens at 6:00am**. Grooming will be available in the Livestock and Horse Barns. **There will be NO day parking on the fairgrounds.**

Overnight Reserved Parking

Overnight parking will be handled by J.I.F.Y.S, PO Box 187, Boring, OR, 97009. Overnight parking is **\$40 per night** pre-reserved. Tow vehicles are an **additional \$15** for the whole weekend. **Checks should be made payable to OKC** and mailed to J.I.F.Y.S. There will be a \$25 charge for returned checks. Day parking is **\$5 per day**. Refund requests must be in writing and post marked on or before August 3rd, 2011. Refunds will be subject to a \$3.00 service fee and will be refunded two weeks after the show. **If your club wishes to reserve parking for club festivities/banquets or your group wishes to park together, requests with payment made payable to OKC** should be sent to J.I.F.Y.S. as soon as possible. It you plan on having more than one vehicle per spot, each additional vehicle will be charged **\$15.00 for the weekend** and MUST fit within your assigned space. **Note: There are no guarantees that your reserved parking will be inside the fairgrounds or close to your assigned ring. Layout and assignment of spaces will be handled exclusively by J.I.F.Y.S. – do not contact OKC regarding parking requests.**

- Vehicles illegally parked may be towed at owner's expenses with no prior notification.
- Reservations must be post marked on or before Wednesday, August 03, 2011.
- There will be an additional \$10.00 charge at the gate for those without a reservation- cash only.
- All reserved parking must check in at SOUTH parking lot. Reserved parking will be available at 2:00 pm Wednesday, August 17, 2011. MAIN GATE WILL CLOSE NIGHTLY AT 11:00 PM. ALL OTHER GATES WILL CLOSE AT 8:00PM
- Assignment of spaces will be made according to size and dimension of vehicle for best use of the parking space available. Misstated vehicle size may result in reassignment of space.
- All vehicles must park as directed by the parking personnel.
- If you wish to park near someone, reservations must be mailed in the same envelope.
- All overnight parking units must be self-contained. No dumping of gray water or sewage.
- All overnight units must have a working fire extinguisher and generator exhaust piping.
- Only One vehicle Per space unless extra parking is purchased. All extra vehicles Must fit within assigned reserved space.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- *Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.*
- *Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.*
- *Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of pure bred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.*
- *The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.*
- *The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.*
- *The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.*
- *The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.*
- *The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of pure bred dogs.*
- *Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.*
- *Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.*
- *Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.*
- *Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.*
- *Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.*
- *Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.*
- *Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.*
